

BYLAW NAME: Burnaby Highway Closure Bylaw No. 9, 2023

(Road Closure #23-04)

Purpose: To close certain portions of highway – closure at a triangular portion of Bevan Street (those parcels or tracts of land known and described as those portions of road dedicated in District Lot 155A, Group 1, New Westminster District, by (a) Plan NWP1425, and containing 0.122ha, identified as Parcel A; and (b) Plan BCP15343 and containing 131.2m², identified as Parcel B on Reference Plan EPP133634 prepared by Gary Rowbotham, B.C.L.S.
