» **[6.1 Investing in Burnaby Parks](#)**

City Council approved a plan to revitalize and improve playgrounds across the city, and forwarded a copy of the new playground program to the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission for feedback. The new program outlines a plan to replace more playgrounds per year in Burnaby, and to add new enhanced and destination playgrounds at major parks in the city over the next six years.

» **[6.2 Period Promise Campaign Update](#)**

City Council voted to expand the Period Promise campaign, which provides menstrual products free of charge at City facilities. The initial campaign was launched in January. By June 2022, 5,260 menstrual products had been distributed at six different City facilities. The expanded program will include dispensing machines in an additional 148 public washrooms at various City facilities.

» **[6.4 Unsightly Property at 7749 Rayside Avenue](#)**

City Council authorized staff to clean up an unoccupied property at 7749 Rayside Avenue. The site has been the subject of four complaints due to overgrowth of vegetation and discarded materials.
