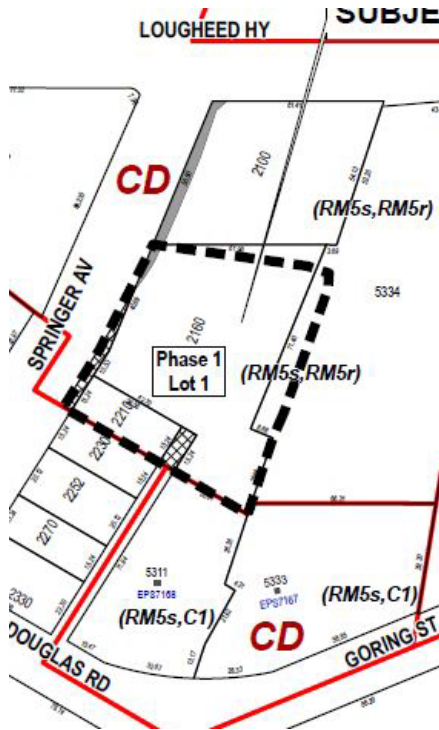


# Public Notice: Highway Closure Bylaw

Notice is hereby given pursuant to section 40 of the *Community Charter*, that a proposed Highway Closure Bylaw be presented before City Council for final adoption at the regular Council Meeting scheduled on **January 15, 2024**.

**BYLAW NAME:** Burnaby Highway Closure Bylaw No. 7, 2023  
(Road Closure #23-03)

**Purpose:** To close certain portions of highway – closure of a portion of 5334 Loughheed Highway; lane allowance at the rear of 2210 Springer Avenue and portion of Springer Avenue road allowance (Bassano Site) (those parcels or tracts of land known and described as those portion of road dedicated in District Lot 125, Group 1, New Westminster District, by (a) Plan 3347, and containing 127.8m<sup>2</sup>; and (b) Plan 12069, and containing 92.9m<sup>2</sup>) as shown on Reference Plan EPP133694 prepared by Patrick Korabek, B.C.L.S.
