Description: Senior secondary students (Grades 11 & 12) will spend an intensive 40 hours working with professional artists and gallery staff. The group takes the role of a professional artist creating an exhibit – students are responsible for creating the artwork featured in the exhibit, as well as developing and promoting the show. The exhibit will be presented in a public location. Students will take a field trip to be introduced to different types of galleries and artists’ works. Students are expected to discuss ideas and be actively involved with the group, create artwork, and experiment outside their comfort zones. There will be some requirement to develop ideas outside of meeting times.
