5180 Glencarin Dr.	Mortimer-Lamb House	2003 May 26	Built in 1928 by nationally recognized artist and pictorial photographer Harold Mortimer-Lamb this house is an important heritage structure in Burnaby Lake Regional Nature Park.
7276 Griffiths Dr.	England House	2003 May 26	Built c.1925 this Romantic Revival Tudor styled cottage is a local neighborhood landmark in the Edmonds Town Centre.
3891 Kingsway	St. John the Divine Anglican Church	2003 June 09 * Bylaws are tabled:12217, 12218 (HRA)	Built in 1905 and designed by architect Joseph Bowman this landmark in Burnaby's Metrotown is the City's oldest church structure.
5141 Sperling Ave.	Woodward Cottage	2003 May 26	Built in 1904 for the Woodward sisters as a home, post-office and private school this cottage is the oldest building in Deer Lake Park and supports the Deer Lake Park heritage precinct.
5145 Sperling Ave.	Moore House	2003 May 26	Built in 1939 in the Arts & Crafts style this house supports the Deer Lake Park heritage precinct.
5195 Sperling Ave.	Woodward House	2003 May 26	Built in 1912 for the Woodward sisters as a home, post-office and private school this house supports the Deer Lake Park heritage precinct.
