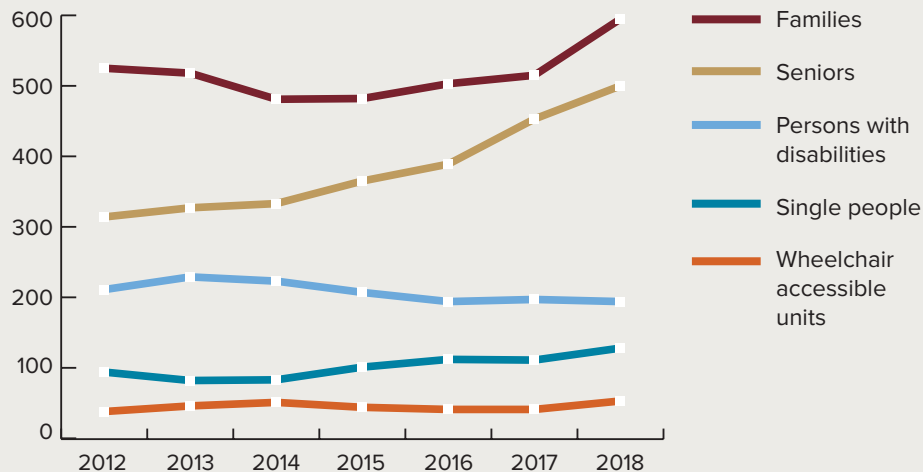

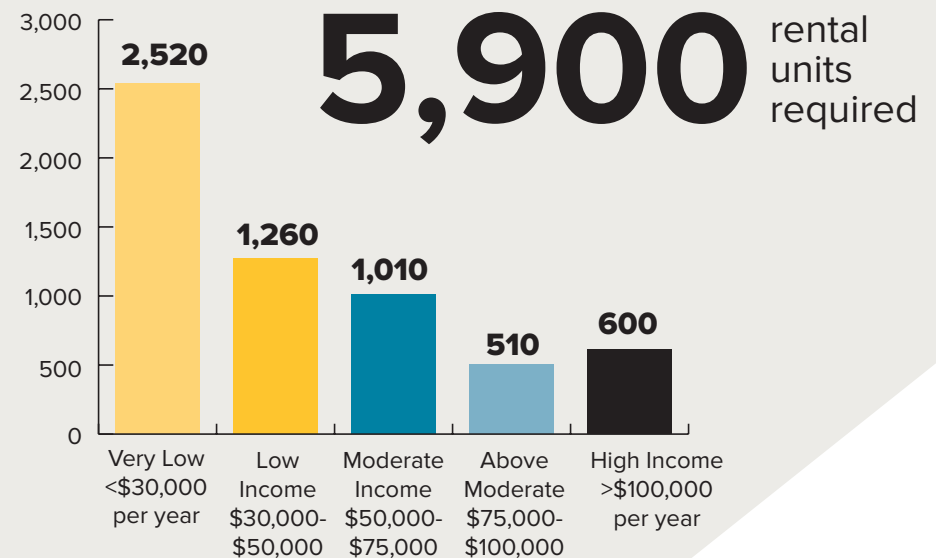
BC Housing Waitlist
