May 1-7 is Emergency Preparedness week. This nationally recognized event highlights the need for all Canadians to get prepared for an emergency.

On Sunday, May 8th, join the City's Emergency Management Office and the Insurance Bureau of Canada at Metropolis at Metrotown to visit the **Shake Zone**, a mobile earthquake simulator. You will experience the powerful shaking of a real earthquake and learn about how to prepare for all types of emergencies. There is a 30% chance a damaging earthquake could happen in the next 50 years. It's not a matter of **IF** an earthquake will happen, but **WHEN**.

So we have a question – Do You 72? Do you have a 72 hours supply of food, water and other items for yourself, your family and your pets? Do you have a plan for what you will do during the first 72 hours after an emergency? Now is the time to get prepared for a



power outage, earthquake or storm. Then you can say You Do 72!
