

CRIME PREVENTION TIPS



Public Safety involves partnerships between the public and the police. Always report suspicious persons or activities to the Burnaby RCMP.



**Theft of vehicles has been increasing in Burnaby!!!!!!!
Currently, motorcycles are being targeted.**

Park It.

Park in a secure garage (if possible).
Place obstacles between the motorcycle & the garage door.

Check on your motorcycle.
Park in view of a camera, in plain view, or where it is well-lit.

Cover it.
Use a generic cover (no brand names) to hide valuable parts that could be stolen & re-sold.

Alarm It.

Buy alarms.
Loud alarms bring public attention to your motorcycle.

Rewire the alarm kill switch.
It takes more time to disarm the alarm.

Use GPS Locators.
It can be hidden in the frame of the motorcycle and it will tell you the location of the motorcycle if stolen.

Lock It.

Use steering locks.
Similar to a car immobilizer; this is a good first defense against theft.

Use Locks and chains.
Wrap the chain through the motorcycle frame. Attach to a secure object such as a lamp post. This makes it harder to lift and steal the motorcycle!

Never leave your keys in the motorcycle;
Not for a second or when parked in a garage.

Car, Truck, or Van Owners Should Take Similar Precautions.

Park it.
In a secure garage or a well-lit area.

Lock it.
Lock all doors and install a wheel lock/immobilizer. Thieves check for unlocked door handles.

Alarm it.
Install an ignition or fuel kill switch. It disables your vehicle when "off".
