Break and Enter To Residence Alert!

Residential break and enters ordinarily increase in April & May due to the warmer weather, as many of us are returning to leaving windows and doors open for air flow. Locking your windows and doors can reduce crime



Did you know that criminals:

- ✱ **Can fit through the tiniest openings?**
The window should not be open large enough to allow someone to reach through or push in the screen.
- ✱ **Know your hiding spots for spare keys?**
Make it more inconspicuous and give it to a trusted neighbour.
- ✱ **Steal your garage opener & break into your home?**
If you chose to have your garage door opener in your vehicle, make sure it is not visible. A better option is to remove it from your vehicle.

- **Lock your doors and use immobilizing devices.**
