

**APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION AS A  
NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTOR IN THE CITY OF BURNABY**

- (1) I declare that I meet the following requirements:
- a) I am a Canadian citizen;
  - b) I am 18 years of age or older today, **OR** if an election is in progress, I will be 18 years of age or older on general voting day for the election;
  - c) I have been a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before today;
  - d) I have been a registered owner of real property in the City of Burnaby for at least 30 days immediately before today;
  - e) I am not holding the property in trust for a corporation or any other trust;
  - f) I am not entitled to register as a resident elector in the City of Burnaby;
  - g) I have not registered as a non-resident property elector in relation to any other parcel of real property in the City of Burnaby;
  - h) I have received the written consent of the majority of individuals registered as owners of the real property to be registered as the non-resident property elector for this property (if there is more than one owner of the property); and
  - i) I am not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election and am not otherwise disqualified by law.

**The form must be completed in ink.** Pencil is not acceptable.

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- (1) You must meet all of the requirements in this section in order to register as a Non-Resident Property Elector.
- (2) Print applicant's surname and given names in full in block letters here.
- (3) Print the street address or legal description of the applicant's real property in relation to which the applicant is registering. Applicant must attach satisfactory proof that he/she is entitled to register in relation to the real property referred to in Part (3) of the application form (e.g. certificate of title, property tax notice, property assessment notice).
- (4) Print the applicant's mailing address including street number and name, city/town and postal code.
- (5) Print either the last six digits of the applicant's social insurance number or the applicant's birthdate. This information is required pursuant to the *Local Government Act*.
- (6) Complete this section if the applicant's name has changed since previously registering as a Non-Resident Property Elector.
- (7) Applicant must sign the application form in the presence of a witness.
- (8) The witness to applicant's signature must sign the application form.
- (9) Print residential address of the witness. Not required if the witness is an election official.
- (10) The applicant must attach the "Non-Resident Property Elector Consent Form" if the land title registration indicates that there is more than one individual who is the registered owner of the real property. The person registering must do so with the written consent of the number of those individuals who, together with the person registering, are a majority of those individuals.
- (11) If person is registering at the time of voting, 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) are required to prove identity.
