Plumbing Fixture Standards

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform owners, designers, contractors and developers about the requirements of new Plumbing Fixture Standards in the B.C. Building Code.

"This information is provided for convenience only and is not in substitution of applicable City Bylaws or Provincial or Federal Codes or laws. You must satisfy yourself that any existing or proposed construction or other works complies with such Bylaws, Codes or other laws."

On 2011 February 01, Part 10 of the B.C. Building Code was amended requiring high-efficiency toilets and urinals and becomes effective on 2011 October 03..

Effective for all building permit applications submitted on or after **2011 October 03** all installations of:

- new toilets for residential (Group C) buildings, such as houses, townhouses, apartments, hotels, etc., shall be high-efficiency toilets having a maximum flush volume of 4.8 litres or less. Dual-flush toilets providing a dual flush cycle option of both 4.1 litres or less and 6.0 litres are also acceptable. The requirement for toilets with a maximum flush volume of 6.0 litres in buildings other than residential will remain unchanged.
- new urinals for all buildings shall be high-efficiency urinals with a flush volume of 1.9 liters or less.
