- » **A “systems-thinking” approach** - recognizes that the city is an urban system in which the built, natural and human environments are all highly connected.
- » **Climate-focused** - recognizes that priorities, policies and decisions need to account for climate change and adaptation.
- » **Innovative and forward-thinking** - demonstrating leadership.

## What is the process?

The OCP project is a multi-year process with 4 phases.



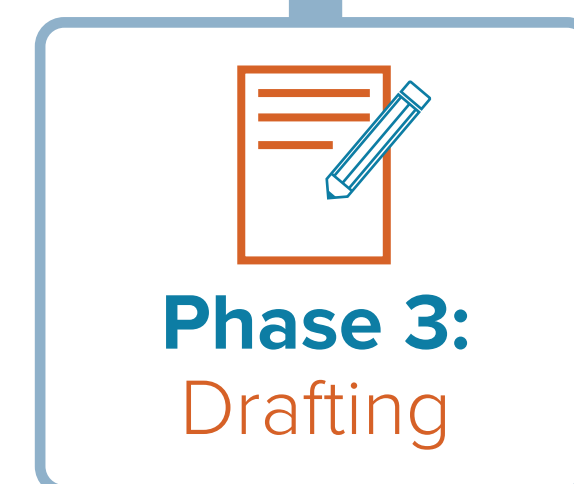
**Phase 1:**  
Surfacing

Raise awareness and invite the community to learn more about the project.



**Phase 2:**  
Visioning

Prepare a vision for the future of the City and prepare growth scenario options.



**Phase 3:**  
Drafting

Set the strategic direction and policies to achieve the draft vision, goals and objectives.



**Phase 4:**  
Confirming

Engage and confirm that the draft OCP reflects the values and priorities of the community.
