FIREWORKS

- » The use of fireworks in Burnaby is tightly controlled and may only happen under certain conditions.
- » All fireworks operators must be at least 18 years of age.
- » Low-hazard fireworks on private property may only be set off on October 31, with the consent of the owner of the property.
- » Setting off fireworks on public property may only be done as part of a special event, and requires a permit from the Burnaby Fire Chief.
- » The sale of fireworks is illegal in Burnaby.
- » The sale, use and possession of firecrackers is illegal in Burnaby.
- » Educate children to stay clear of open flames and other heat sources. Ensure that children know how to perform **STOP**, **DROP** and **ROLL** should their clothes catch on fire.
