» 6.1 Budget Request to Support Prism Implementation: Manager of Aquatics

City Council approved the create a new Manager of Aquatics position. This manager will oversee the deployment of a new registration system while also focusing on decreasing swim lesson waitlists, offering innovative programs through the school district and ensuring the City has the staffing levels in place to open new aquatic facilities over the next four years.

» 6.6 2023 Infrastructure Canada Active Transportation Fund - Vancouver-SFU Active Transportation Connection Project

City Council endorsed the Vancouver-SFU Active Transportation Connection Project. The 8.9-kilometre project will identify existing gaps and opportunities along the Union-Frances Bikeway and the Burnaby Mountain Bikeway with the objective of upgrading the cycling route to an All Ages and Abilities (AAA) facility. The federal government has agreed to contribute \$5.7 million towards the project.

» 7.3 Planning and Development Committee - RE: Burnaby District Energy Policy

City Council adopted the Draft Burnaby District Energy Policy and directed staff to continue to advance work on the final version of this policy, which will ensure future buildings are designed to be compatible with a future district energy system in Burnaby. The proposed district energy system would take excess heat from the Metro Vancouver Waste to Energy Facility, to be used as a low-carbon option to heat homes in south Burnaby.
