HERE'S WHAT YOU MISSED (June 19th, 2025):

- Elder abuse is a growing concern and involves crimes like assault, fraud and theft.
- The types of abuses include:
 - Financial: theft, coercion, and misuse of funds.
 - **Emotional:** isolation, verbal abuse, control.
 - **Physical:** neglect, confinement and overmedication.
- The abuser is often familiar which may include family, friends, caregivers, and/or neighbors.
- Seniors have lost over \$8,000—\$15,000, and most fraud goes unreported due to shame or fear of embarrassment.
