» 8.1 Policy Directions for Naming and Commemoration Policy Framework

City Council directed staff to prepare policies in alignment with the draft naming and commemoration framework. The framework provides a set of overarching principles to guide the City's approach to naming and commemoration with regards to civic assets, streets, commemorative plaques and interpretive signage, as well as when honouring individuals.

» 8.4 Bicycle Donations

City Council authorized staff to begin donating abandoned bicycles to local community charity groups. Prior to this authorization, abandoned bicycles were stored for 90 days before being sold through a third-party auction. As part of this program, City staff will produce an annual report outlining the number of bikes donated and the recipient organizations.
