### HOMELESSNESS: INTERVENTION SUPPORT — SESSION SUMMARY

#### **HERE'S WHAT YOU MISSED** (July 10th, 2025):

- The Intervention Support Team delivers compassionate, trauma-informed outreach to individuals experiencing or at risk of homelessness in Burnaby.
- The goal of the team is to resolve issues without police/bylaws involvement.
- What They Do:
  - Make referrals to housing, health care, detox/treatment and income supports
  - Help with ID, clothing, hygiene and access to food
- What They Don't Do:
  - Enforcement or forced removals
  - Clinical or criminal response
- Some of the results of the new program includes 100+ encampments assisted, 30+ people connected to income support and disability assistance, and reduced calls to RCMP and Bylaws.
