» 7.1 Burnaby 2050 Official Community Plan - Final Report

City Council was presented with the Burnaby 2050 Official Community Plan Bylaw. Council gave first and second readings to the bylaw and advanced it to a public hearing scheduled for October 6. The new OCP was developed over three years and included the most robust public consultation program in Burnaby's history.

» 7.2 Mayor's Task Force on Burnaby Economic Growth and Resilience

City Council approved the creation of the Mayor's Task Force on Burnaby Economic Growth and Resilience, as well as guiding principles and core responsibilities to guide the work of the Task Force. Recruitment for the Task Force will be launched in the coming weeks, with the group set to convene in January 2026.

» 8.4 Revenue Opportunity: Modernization of City Driving Ranges

City Council approved the modernization of driving ranges at Burnaby Mountain and Riverway golf courses. The new ranges will include a hybrid model of traditional practice stalls with interactive, technology-enabled bays, as well as lounge-style bays with seating, screens and games.
