City Council approved a Temporary Use Permit for the property at 6800 Lougheed Highway, to permit the owner to construct temporary amenities on the site, such as pickleball courts and a recreation/fitness area while the existing warehouse is used as a presentation centre.

» [8.4 Electric Kick Scooter Pilot Project](#)

Council approved the City of Burnaby's participation in the Provincial Electric Kick Scooter Pilot Project. This pilot project enables municipalities to explore how electric kick scooters can be safely and effectively integrated into local transportation systems. Participation in the pilot will provide an opportunity to assess the impacts of electric kick scooters within a structured and regulated environment. Data collected on usage, safety, and operational along with ongoing monitoring will also inform future policy development and help define the role of electric kick scooters within the transportation network.
