» 7.1 Mayor Hurley - Proposed Motion: Proposed Zoning Bylaw Amendments - R1 SSMUH District

City Council voted against making further amendments the Burnaby Zoning Bylaw with respect to the R1 small-scale multi-unit housing (SSMUH) District. The changes would have required one parking space per unit of housing, and no more than four units of housing on a lot area less than 623 m^2 .

» 7.5 Salmon Habitat Expansion in Burnaby Fraser Foreshore Park

City Council directed staff to work with the Raincoast Conservation Foundation and the Department of Fisheries and Oceans on the proposed salmon habitat enhancement project in Burnaby Fraser Foreshore Park.

» 7.9 Mural Funding Proposal - Bus Shelter Pilot

City Council approved funding to apply artistic vinyl murals on six Burnaby bus shelters. Staff identified the six locations due to high volumes of graffiti, as the vinyl murals will also protect the glass and make graffiti removal easier and more cost effective should vandalism occur. The pilot project will utilize original artwork by Burnaby artists through the Burnaby Public Artist Roster.

» 7.10 CA - Burnaby Animal Shelter

Council awarded a contract of \$5,000,000 for the construction of a new Burnaby Animal Shelter at 3202 Norland Avenue, to replace the facility that was constructed more than 50 years ago.
