UPDATE: Kensington Avenue northbound curb lane closure

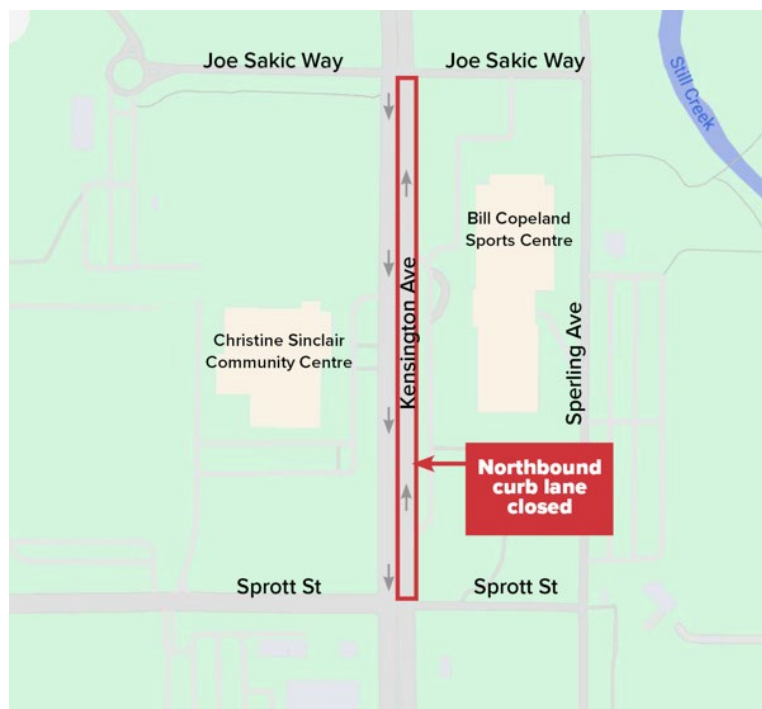
The northbound curb lane on Kensington Avenue between Sprott Street and Joe Sakic Way is closed for utility work related to the Burnaby Lake Recreation Centre project. The closure is expected to remain in place until July 17. Expect heavier traffic in the area.

Access to the Christine Sinclair Community Centre will be maintained.

The southbound bus stop on Kensington Avenue at Joe Sakic Way has been moved north and remains in service during construction. Transit users are encouraged to check TransLink for information on any temporary bus stop adjustments. Pedestrian access will be maintained. Please follow posted signage and allow extra time for travel.

- **Location:** Kensington Avenue between Sprott Street and Joe Sakic Way
- **Expected duration:** Through approximately July 17, 2026
- **Purpose:** Utility work related to the Burnaby Lake Recreation Centre

About the project

The new Burnaby Lake Recreation Centre is being built next to the Bill Copeland Sports Centre. The project replaces the aging CG Brown Memorial Pool and Burnaby Lake Ice Rink with a new 10-lane 50 metre pool, a 6-lane 25 metre pool and an NHL-sized rink, as well as enhanced connectivity and parking.
