IMPORTANT DATES AND VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT REQUIREMENTS

- Mail ballot packages will be available starting the week of September 28, 2026
- After 4:00 pm on October 05, mail ballot packages will ONLY be available by pick-up at the Election Office.
- After 4:00 pm October 05, no further applications for mail ballot will be accepted.
- It is the responsibility of the elector to ensure the completed mail ballot is received by the Chief Election Officer by 8:00 pm on General Voting Day (October 17, 2026).
- **Once you have registered to vote by mail ballot, you cannot vote at any voting location unless you have first surrendered your entire mail ballot package.**
