



Arenas Rental - Multipurpose Room Requests

Hosting - Attending drop-in skating activities – Group Bookings

The City of Burnaby offers rental spaces to host celebrations, socials & meetings. Please review the following information when planning your event.

Drop in Skating Session Information

Many groups choose to attend a Drop-in skating session before, after, or during their room rental. Family & Lap drop-in sessions are not available for group bookings.

Ice & in-line skating is offered seasonally at all Burnaby Arena Facilities – check facility venue page for ice in & out dates!

Inquire about availability during long weekends, statutory holidays, and school closure days

- Admission & skate rental fees must be paid at time of admission to the program; they are not included in the room booking.
- Drop in skating admission is on first come, first-served basis.
- All participants must be present to be admitted and receive a hand stamp as proof of admission.
- No holds of spaces for skaters who are not present at time of admission.
- When ready to attend the session, please have your group gather in the lobby at least 30 mins prior to starting and designate one person to wait in line to pay for admissions and skate rentals.
- 30 mins is required to ensure that rentals can be acquired at the skate shop and prepare your guests for skating
- Once participants are wearing skates, they will have to remove skates to return to the multipurpose room.

Booking Public Skating for Groups

- When booking the multipurpose room, please provide an estimated number of skaters.
- Max 30 people allowed per group booking

Skate Admission and Rental Fees

- BE Active admission fees apply
- Skates are available for rent if required

Drop-In Skating Orientation for Groups

Please review the following information with all participants before attending a public skating session.

General Information

- Skate aids are intended for individuals who are learning to skate and are unable to balance independently.
- In designated lap skating areas, please skate in the direction indicated by staff.
- Games are only permitted when organized and supervised by staff.
- No games such as tag, follow-the-leader, or other activities that may interfere with other skaters.



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Skate Safely - For everyone's enjoyment and safety:

- Always be aware of your surroundings.
- Skate at a speed that allows you to stop and turn safely.
- Maintain a safe distance from other skaters.
- The skater approaching from behind is responsible for yielding and passing safely, like the rules used on ski hills.
