ELECTOR REGISTRATION

Electors who registered with Elections BC prior to July 10, 2026 will receive a voter card in the mail. If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the application form available at the voting place or as part of the mail ballot process and making a declaration that you meet the registration requirements set out below:

RESIDENT ELECTORS

To register as a resident elector, you must:

- be a Canadian citizen;
- be 18 years of age or older on General Voting Day, October 17, 2026;
- be a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);
- be a resident of the City of Burnaby on the day of registration (at time of voting); and
- not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election and not otherwise disqualified by law.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS

To register as a non-resident property elector, you must:

- be a Canadian citizen;
- be 18 years of age or older on General Voting Day, October 17, 2026;
- be a resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);
- be a registered owner of real property in the City of Burnaby for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration (at time of voting);

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- not be entitled to register as a resident elector;
- not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election and not otherwise disqualified by law; and

In addition, for non-resident property electors:

- The only persons who are registered owners of the property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust.
- If more than one individual is a registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with written consent of the majority of the individual owners, register as a non-resident property elector.

In addition, in order to register at time of voting:

Resident electors must produce two (2) pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce two (2) pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, written consent from the majority of the property owners.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

If you wish to vote by mail, you may apply directly online at Burnaby.ca/VoteByMail. If you wish to obtain a paper application, please download and print from Burnaby.ca/VoteByMail, pick up an application at any of the mail ballot drop boxes at the locations listed below, or call 604-294-7088. Paper applications should be submitted by mail to the Election Office c/o Burnaby City Hall (4949 Canada Way, Burnaby, BC V5G 1M2) or in person to the Legislative Services front desk at Burnaby City Hall (4949 Canada Way).

Vote by mail applications will be accepted from 8 am on August 31, 2026, until 4 pm on October 5, 2026.

Information to be submitted in the application includes:

- (1) Full name;
- (2) Residential address;
- (3) Method of delivery of your mail ballot package:
 - pick up at Election Office (6050 Beresford Street) and, if you wish, name of person you authorize to pick up package for you; or
 - regular letter mail through Canada Post to residential address; or
 - regular letter mail through Canada Post to an alternate address that you provide when requesting the ballot package; and
- (4) If you are not on the list of electors, an application to register as a resident voter.

If you wish to vote by mail as a non-resident property elector, please contact the Burnaby Election Office for the necessary forms.

Mail ballots will be issued to approved electors beginning the week of September 28, 2026.

RETURNING YOUR MAIL BALLOT

To be counted, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8 pm on General Voting Day, October 17, 2026.

You may return your completed mail ballot by mail using the return envelope provided, by dropping it off at any of the mail ballot drop boxes listed below, or by delivering it to any voting location on voting days.
